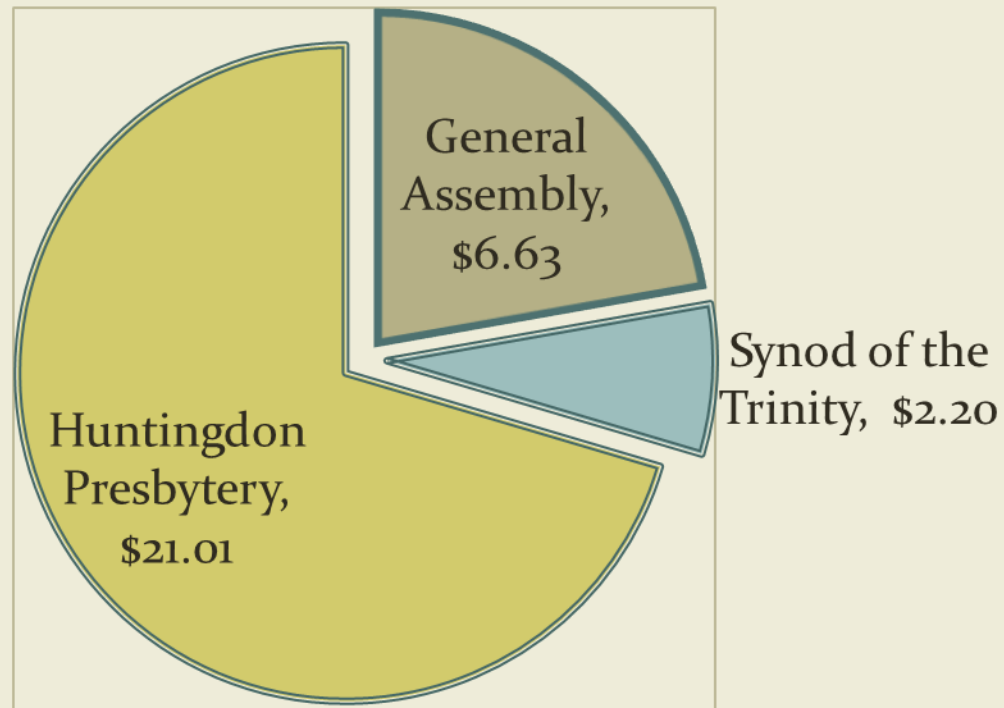


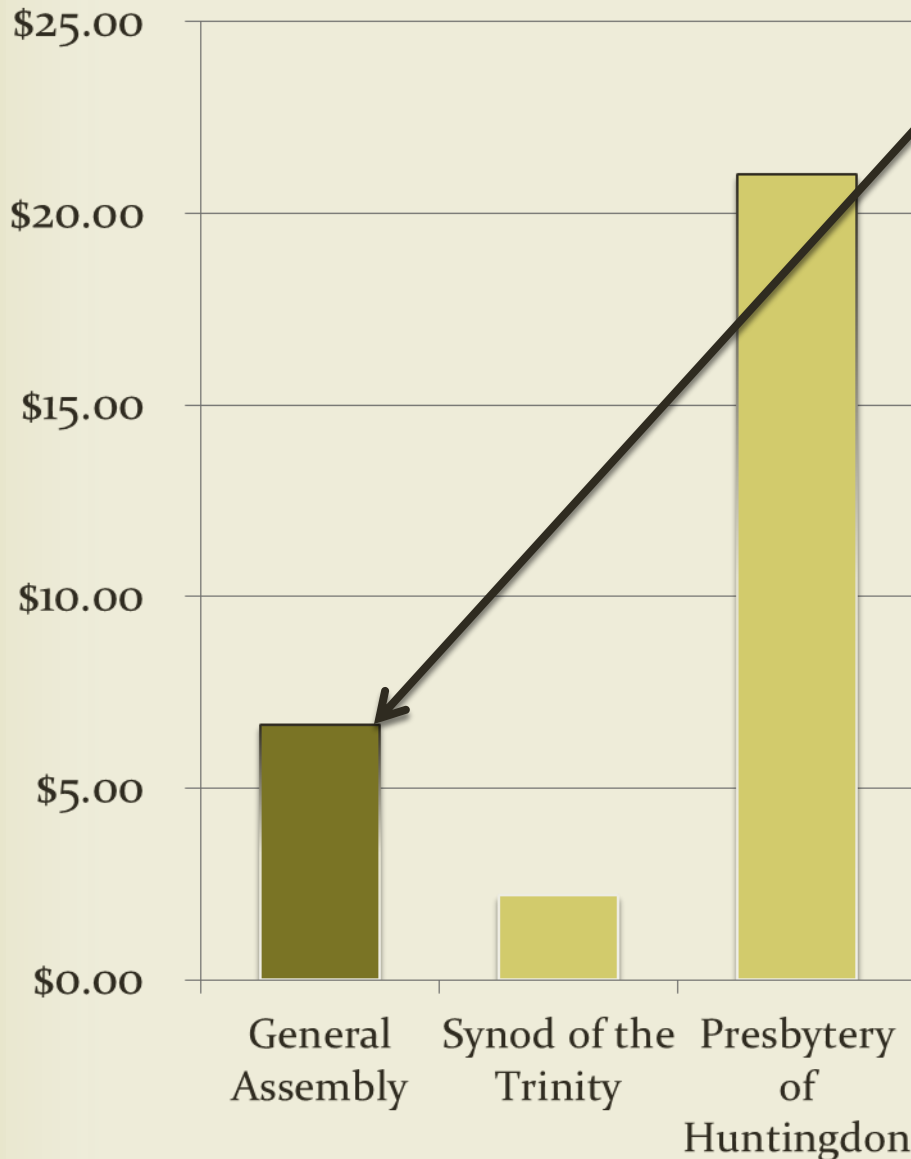

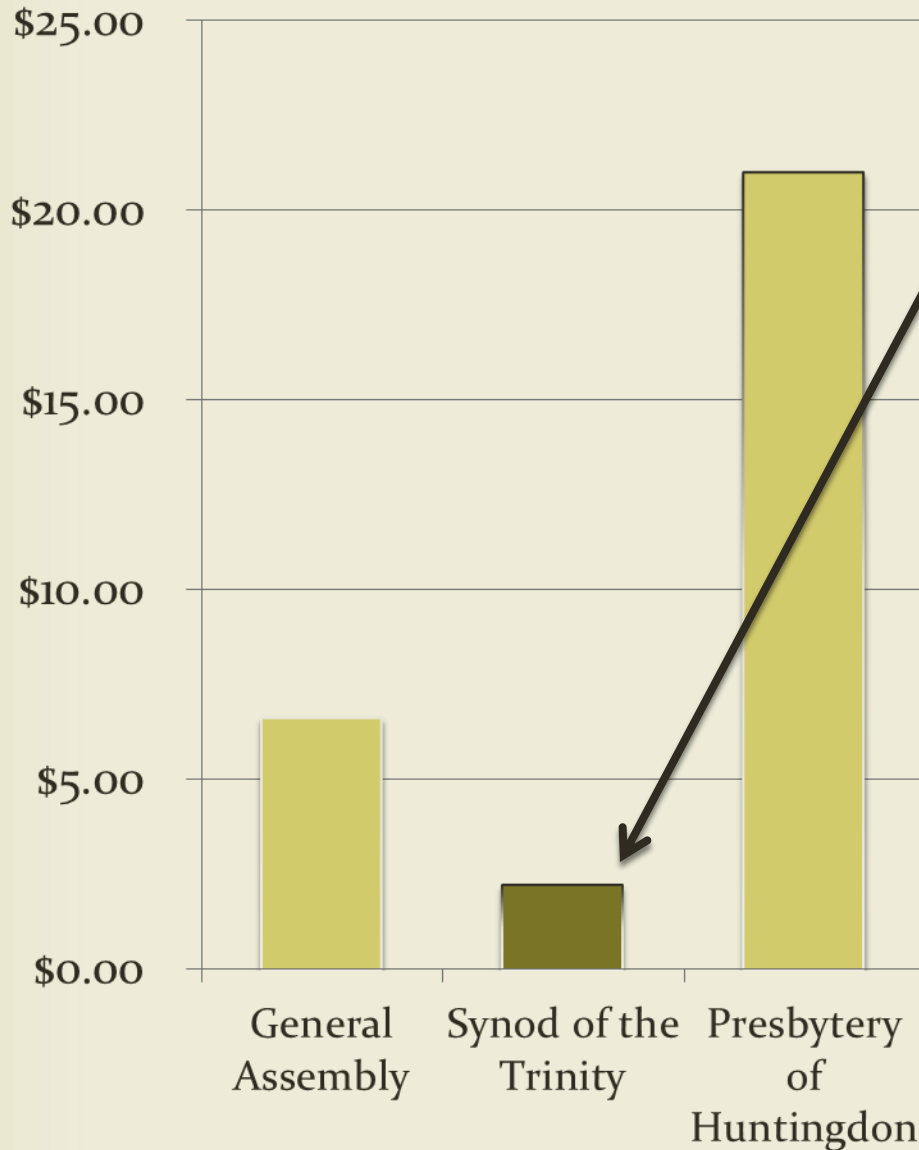


General Assembly



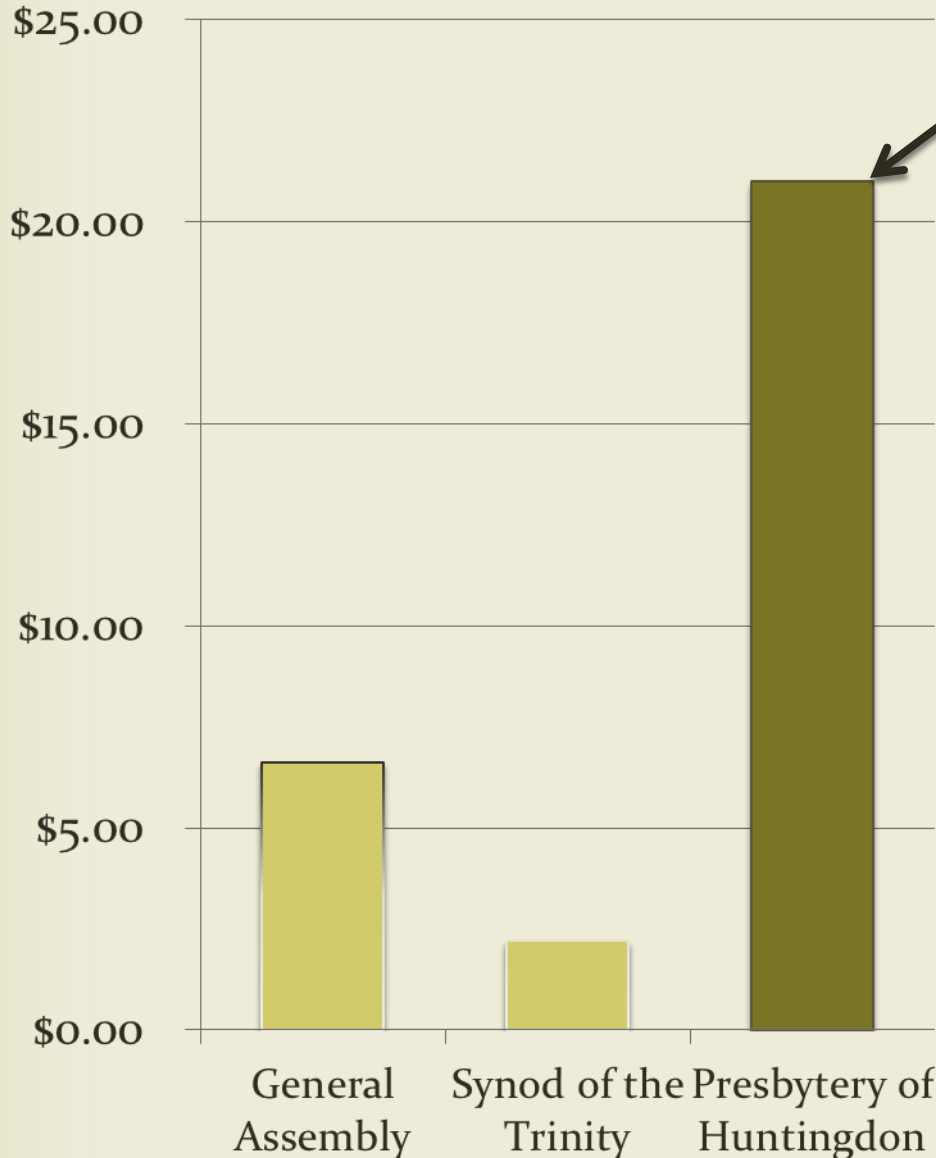
- ❖ Plan General Assembly meetings
- ❖ Operates Church Leadership Connection for finding pastors
- ❖ Develops and implements the Office of General Assembly (OGA) web site
- ❖ Prepares PC (USA) statistics – including the congregations’ tax exemption
- ❖ Provides training for leadership development
- ❖ Coordinates and evaluates the church’s mission efforts
- ❖ Runs the Historical Society which provides a safe and secure way to preserve church records – provide search tools for research
- ❖ Develops and administrators ordination exams
- ❖ Helps Presbyteries with legal questions

Synod of the Trinity



- ❖ Applies for churches PA tax exemptions
- ❖ Leadership training – Child Abuse, Missional Church Thinking for Small Churches
- ❖ Helps fund Missional Church – giving \$18,000 a year for 3 years
- ❖ Holds EP Forum
- ❖ Oversees the administrative review of Presbytery records
- ❖ Assists in starting new churches
- ❖ Initiates new technology – “virtual meetings”
- ❖ Provides Judicial Review (PJC) for situations throughout the Synod – provides training

Presbytery



- ❖ Annual training for elders & deacons, one-on-one training for new clerks
- ❖ Matches churches and potential ministers
- ❖ Provides moderators to churches without ministers
- ❖ Inform churches about upcoming events and other items like changes in tax laws or Board of Pension
- ❖ Reimburse committee members for mileage to attend meetings
- ❖ Resources sessions and pastors on polity issues
- ❖ Hosts annual session records review
- ❖ Keeps Presbytery & minister's records – providing information when needed
- ❖ General Presbyter provides information, training, and troubleshooting with sessions and congregations
- ❖ Hosts the presbytery Resource Center
